Note: only registered voters living within Town limits can vote.


Recommended Voting Method for May 5th Town Elections

**Due to Coronavirus, ALL Voters are now
eligible to vote early from home!**

REQUEST MAILED BALLOT TO VOTE FROM HOME NOW

Town **Voters taking advantage of this recommended option** to vote early from home **should request their absentee ballot now**

in order to ensure receipt of ballot; completion of ballot; and return of ballot by election day.

If you wish to avoid going to the polls on election day due to COVID-19, choose the first option. The second option requires medical approval and a mailed application.

Choose an Absentee Option

Other Non-Recommended Voting Options for May 5th Town Elections

Early In-person Curbside Absentee:

Social distancing measures will be in place for in-person absentee voting at the Office of Elections and Voter Registration, 750 Miller Drive SE, Suite C in Leesburg, Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Saturday, May 2, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with Saturday, May 2, being the final day to vote in-person curbside absentee. Voters will not be permitted in the office to vote. There will

be signs directing voters to contact election officials upon their arrival. Voters do not have to apply in advance to vote in-person curbside absentee.

Election Day (May 5) In-person at Voting Precinct:

Please note that voters choosing to vote on election day at a precinct will be subject to strict social distancing measures including no more than 10 people in the room at one time and at least 6' between each person. Voters choosing this method will likely experience longer than normal wait times; therefore, **you are strongly encouraged to vote at home using the recommended method explained in the pink section above.**

Voter Registration Deadlines:

All voters are encouraged to double check their registration. Voters can check/update their status and/or register [here](#). Keep in mind the following registration deadlines:

- **Online Voter Registration:** Monday, April 13, 2020, at 11:59 p.m.
- **In-Person Voter Registration:** Monday, April 13, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. at the Office of Elections and Voter Registration, 750 Miller Drive SE, Suite C in Leesburg. Please note: Voters will not be permitted into the office. Applications will be available in the lobby and can be completed on-site and dropped off.

- **By-Mail Voter Registration:** The application must be postmarked no later than April 13, 2020.
