Loudoun COVID-19 Business Interruption Grant (Round 3)

Eligible business owners,

The County is accepting grant applications now until Saturday, June 6th at Noon!

All business grant applications received during the open application period will be verified by county staff, placed into a drawing pool, and randomly selected until the \$2 million small business interruption grant fund has been exhausted.

Your application must be received by June 6 at Noon.

The fund will provide 400 randomly selected applicant businesses with a \$5,000 grant. Applications must demonstrate all of the following eligibility requirements:

- **Have between zero and two, W-2 employees (no limit on 1099 contractors).**
- **Have less than \$2.5 million in gross annual receipts.**
- **Have at least a 25% loss in revenue that can be attributed to COVID-19.**
- **Be a licensed and operational for-profit business in Loudoun.**
- **Must not have received a grant from the COVID-19 Business Interruption Grant in Round 1 or 2.**
