Safety and Operational Study Leesburg to Prince William County

Dear Catoctin District Residents,

Loudoun County is conducting a Route 15 South Safety and Operational Study to identify safety and traffic operational issues related to the roadway, which includes approximately 12 miles of Route 15 from the southern corporate limit of the Town of Leesburg to the Prince William County boundary.

The county is working with the public to ensure any proposed improvements along Route 15 South will continue to carry local and commuter traffic safely and efficiently while preserving the unique context of the historical roadway.

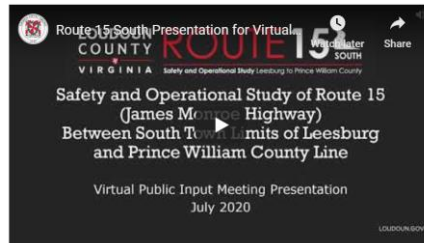
How to Submit a Question
