Should a bioterrorism event or health emergency, such as Pandemic Flu, require it, the Loudoun County Health Department is preparing for the possibility of opening emergency mass vaccination and medication dispensing sites to protect our citizens.

**MRC members, both medically trained and non-medical volunteers, will be vital in staffing these sites.**

Non-medically trained volunteers perform key clinic support roles such as registration, data entry, language translation, foot traffic control, medical personnel assistance, logistics, etc.

MRC members may also assist the health department with other public health responses in our community if they so desire.

### *Are You and Your Family Prepared For An Emergency?*

- Do you have a 3 to 5 day supply of water and food?
- Do you know where to go in an emergency?
- Do you test your smoke alarms monthly?
- Do you know basic first aid and CPR?
- Do you have a first aid kit?
- Do you have a fire extinguisher in your kitchen?
- Do you have at least two escape routes from your home?
- Do you have copies of important documents and identification?
- Do you have a battery powered radio and flashlight with plenty of extra batteries?

### **If you decide to become part of our Medical Reserve Corps you will:**

1. Receive an orientation by the Health Department concerning your role in the MRC. (no other meetings are required)
2. Play a significant role in keeping your family and community safe.
3. Be offered free training on such topics as CPR, First Aid, and emergency preparedness.

*You don't have to be a Doctor, Nurse or other Healthcare professional to volunteer for the Loudoun Medical Reserve Corps.*

*You should consider volunteering if:*

1. *You want to help keep Loudoun County residents safe from an outbreak of disease,*
2. *You are able to serve in an emergency, and*
3. *You are a Loudoun County resident at least 16 years of age.*
