MD Man Arrested in Regional Thefts of Credit Cards, Additional Suspects Sought

Loudoun County, VA- Following the arrest of a Maryland man this week, the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office is working to identify four suspects involved in a credit card theft spree targeting vehicles in the region.

The group has been targeting vehicles, most of which have been parked at National Parks in Maryland and West Virginia, and stealing credit cards. The credit cards have been used fraudulently at area locations, including some stores in Loudoun County.

Damon R. Albert, 43, was arrested October 26 for using the stolen credit cards to purchase items in Loudoun County. Albert is charged with two counts of credit card fraud and two counts of forgery. Additional charges are pending.

Detectives with the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Financial Crimes Unit have been working with the Frederick County (MD) Sheriff's Office, Maryland Department of Natural Resources Police, the United States Park Police, Maryland State Police, the Washington County Sheriff's Office and the Hagerstown Police Department.
